



# Colorado K-12 Issues Poll

*March 1, 2022*

## Methodology

---

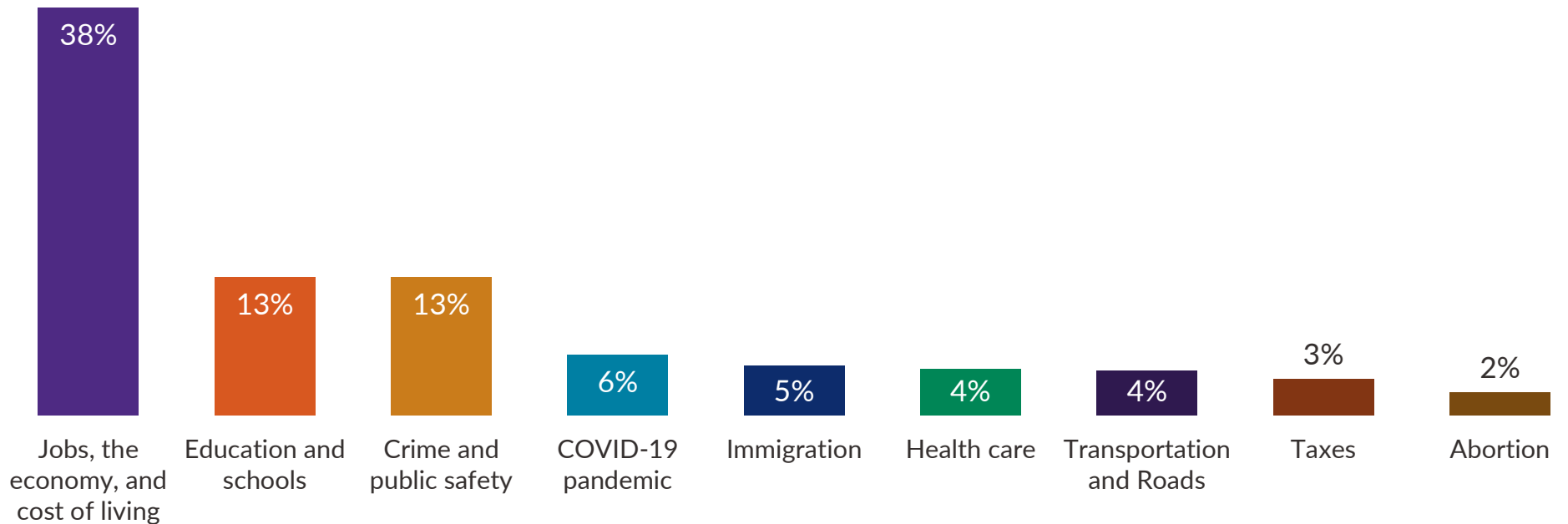
- Results based on a hybrid sample of 600 likely November 2022 voters statewide in Colorado, including 300 voters contacted with live interviewers and 300 responses from an online panel.
- The sample is distributed to accurately represent likely November 2022 voters based on party, gender, age, geography, ethnicity, vote history and education.
- Worst-case margin of error  $\pm 4\%$ , among all respondents, larger margin of error among subgroups.
- This poll was conducted from February 24-27, 2021, by Keating Research, Inc.



# 4-10 Voters: Jobs, Economy and Cost of Living Most Important Issue

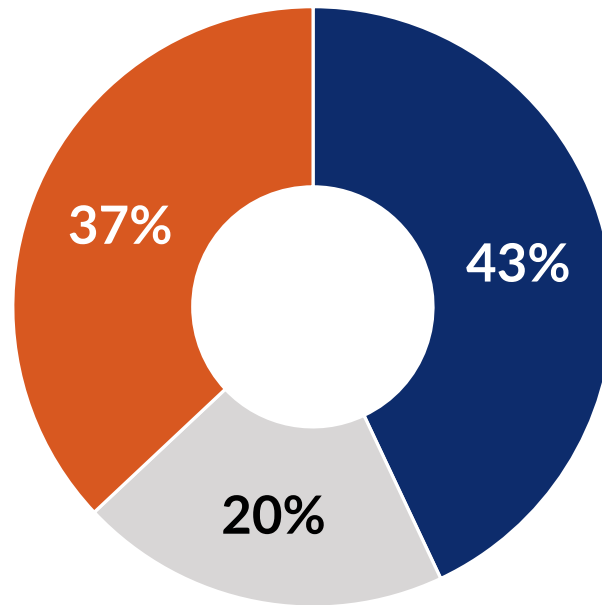
## Education and Crime Round Out Top Three Issues

Which ONE of the following would you say is the most important issue facing Colorado?



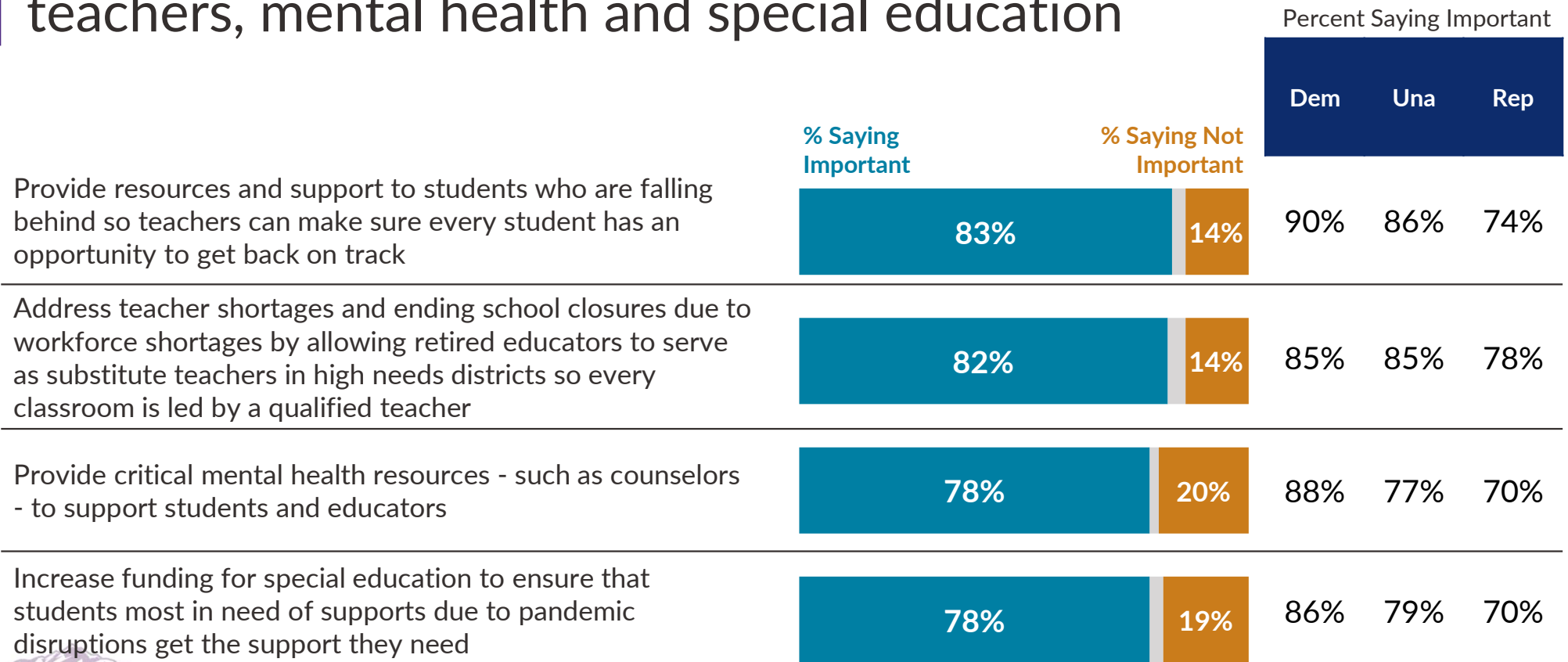
# Voters Are More Likely to Trust Democrats on Education Issues

When it comes to issues related to schools and K-12 education, would you say you are generally – more likely to trust Democrats or more likely to trust Republicans?

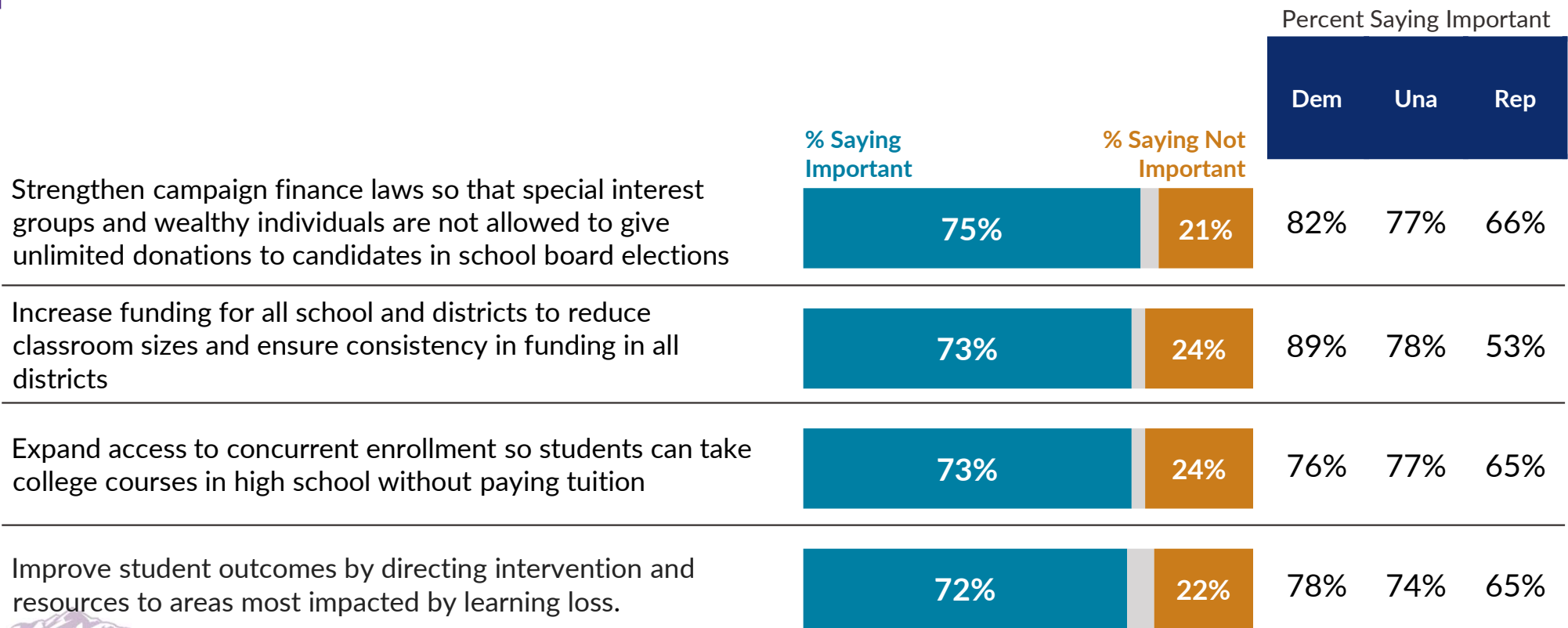


- More Likely to Trust Democrats

- More Likely to Trust Republicans

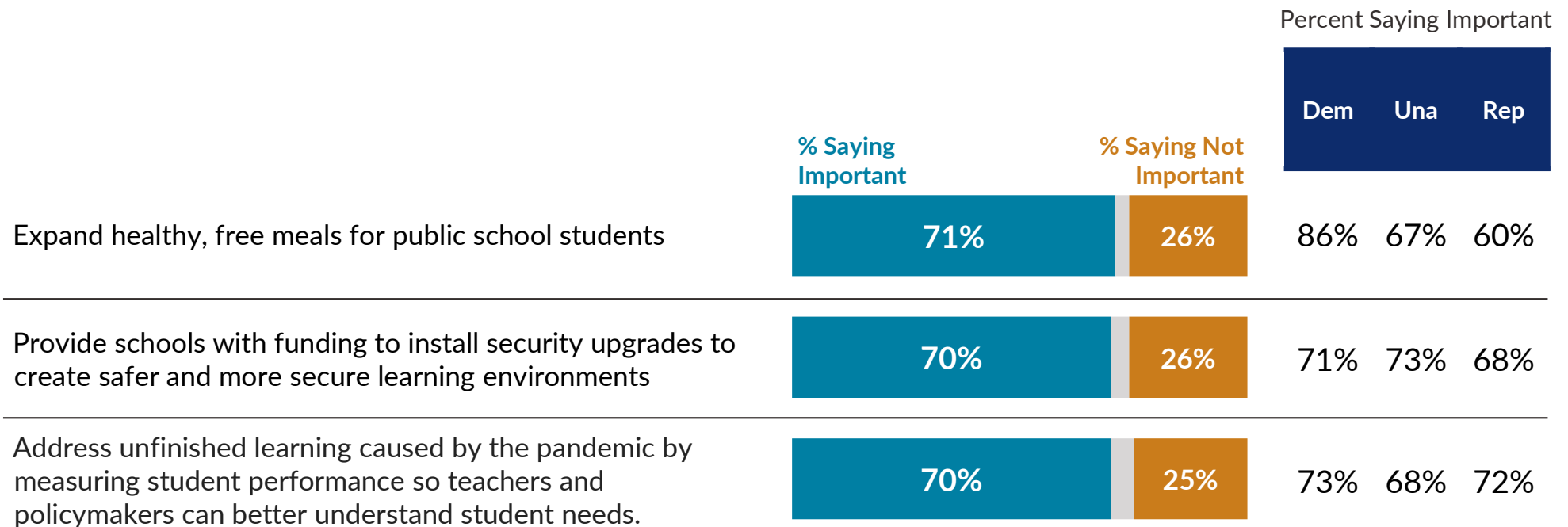
# K-12 Legislative Priorities: More resources for students, teachers, mental health and special education



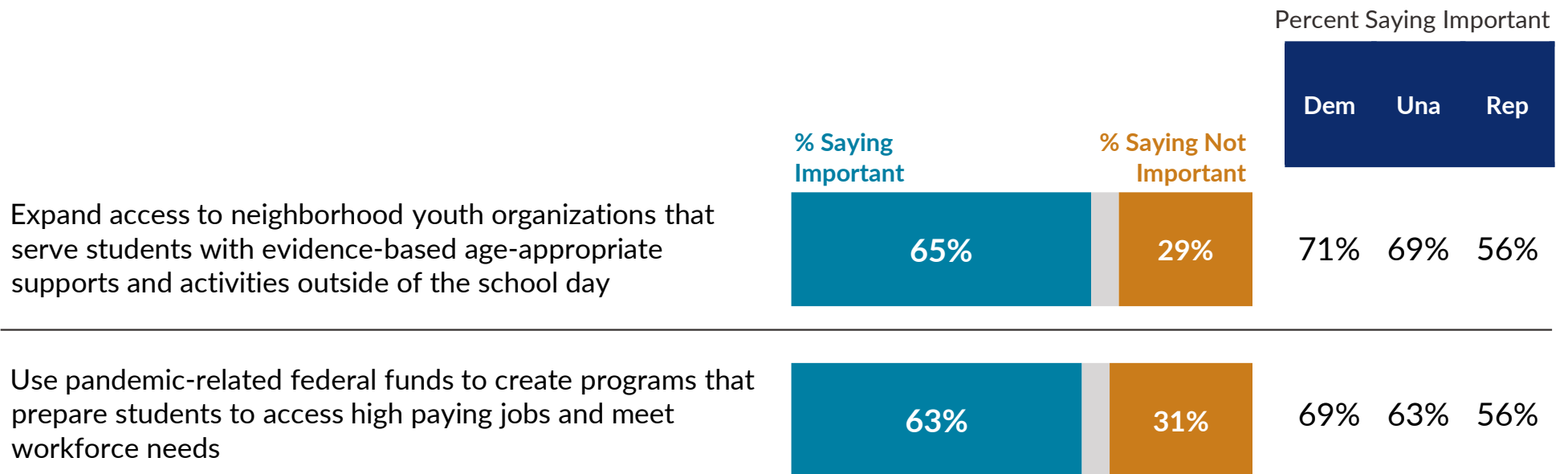
## K-12 Legislative Priorities: Expanding concurrent enrollment, addressing learning loss, and limiting campaign contributions

## ***K-12 Legislative Priorities:*** Expanding access to neighborhood youth organizations and programs that prepare students for careers



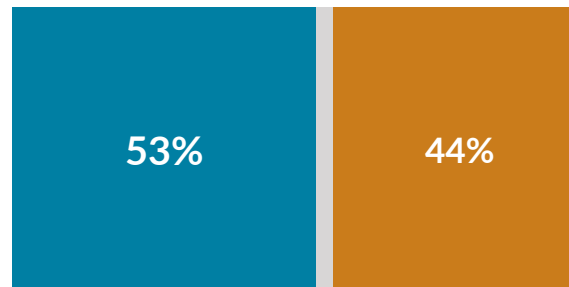


# Transparency is important, but partisan efforts leave “curriculum transparency” ranked least important K-12 policy
